Meth Lab on Six Mile Road

Somerville -

Sheriff Greg Bartlett reports that on January 14, 2009, Morgan County Sheriff's Deputies were sent to check the welfare of a child at a residence on Six Mile Road in Somerville, Morgan County, Alabama. Deputies parked away from the residence and were walking up to the residence to avoid detection. While Deputies were crossing the yard of 10 Pence Road Somerville, Morgan County, Alabama, persons in an outbuilding began fleeing on foot.

Deputies went to the residence where the persons were fleeing from the outbuilding to ask the homeowner if his/her outbuilding was being burglarized. The person who came to the door had active warrants for his arrest. Deputies then went to the outbuilding to investigate the suspicious activity. When they knocked and announced their presence, a person inside the outbuilding opened the door and Deputies observed a clandestine methamphetamine laboratory from the doorway. The Deputies detained the people in the outbuilding and notified the Morgan County Drug Task Force of the situation. A search warrant was obtained for the property and a clandestine methamphetamine laboratory was located, and there were three arrests.

Mark Franklin Morrow age 39, Paul William Hatfield age 32, and Robie Justine Sullins age 19, were arrested for unlawful manufacturing of a controlled substance 1st degree and are being held in the Morgan County Detention Facility on a \$5,000.00 bond each.
