Terrorist Threats

Somerville -

Sheriff Greg Bartlett reports that his investigators have charged 43 year old Huntsville man with Terrorist Threat, a Class C Felony.

On May 14th, 2009 a deputy responded to a call for service at a Somerville address. The complainant was receiving death threats over the phone, targeting both her and her 8 year old daughter.

While taking the complaint, numerous other calls from the same person were received. The deputy listened to all of them. There were repeated threats of violence against the complainant and her child. The deputy spoke with the suspect, and he repeated the threats, and also threatened to kill the deputy.

STEPHEN BARRY ALLAN, 43, of 7803 Michael Circle in Huntsville was arrested in Limestone County on Friday night on an initial charge of harassment and booked into the Morgan County Jail with a \$5,000 bond and a hold for investigators. Criminal Investigators reviewed the case Monday morning. They discovered that this was an ongoing pattern of abuse and threats from ALLAN, directed towards his ex-wife and child. Investigators determined that ALLAN was a convicted felon, and that the threats were credible given a previous history of violence in the relationship. He was charged with one count of Terrorist Threat. He remains in the Morgan County Jail in lieu of \$30,000 bond.
