Teen located

Sheriff Greg Bartlett reports that his patrol division deputies acted quickly and efficiently in locating a Lincoln County Tennessee teenager who authorities there reported was probably in Morgan County and was possibly in danger.

At around 7:10 P.M. on Tuesday night, Lincoln County Tennessee Sheriff's deputies contacted Morgan County with a request for assistance. A 16 year old male had been reported missing by his mother. The juvenile was reportedly "out of control" and despondent. The juvenile had left in a family owned pick up truck. The mother had been able to contact the juvenile by cell phone. He told his mother that he was going to his father's grave site, which is in Morgan County, and that he would "...be home tomorrow." The mother and Lincoln County Officials were concerned that the juvenile might do something irrational.

Lt John Bili directed Deputies Eric Fields and Garry Landers to attempt to locate the juvenile. Ten minutes later, the juvenile was located unharmed and safely detained until his mother arrived from Tennessee to pick him up.

Sheriff Bartlett credits the cooperation between Law Enforcement Agencies and the swift and professional response of his deputies with the safe return of this juvenile to his family.
